Out with old and in with the new is the challenge during the Saturn/Uranus opposition. This is an unusual cycle, which you would expect, Uranus never does things Saturn's way! The planets meet each other in this opposing position every 42-48 years; different signs alter the length of the cycle. Between 1900 and 2008 there have only been three such occasions, 1918, 1965 and 2008. The planets meet 5 times in each opposition, and this time around, it will be five again, although the next cycle 2056 will be only three hits.

Welcome to the final planet watch for the calendar year, early this month Mercury is too close to the Sun for observation, but by the 20th the elusive trickster emerges from the Sun's beams appearing low in the western twilight. The messenger has a meeting with night "Guru" Jupiter on 30th, both appearing low in the west at Sunset. Your best chance to catch this encounter of the smallest and largest planet starts on the 29th to the 31st. The 29th offers something special, the show begins around 20:00 AEDT (8:00pm) on the western horizon with the new 1.67 day old Crescent Moon sitting between the two. You might like to put this date in your diary, as this may turn out to be a beautiful evening sight.

Venus continues its rendezvous with the Guru, Jupiter, joined by a three-day old waxing Moon on December 1, lighting up the early evening twilight. As the Sun sets, the show starts and continues until 22:00 AEDT (10:00pm).

Mars is burnt to a crisp this month as it is combust the Sun. The two have their engagement on the 14th with Mars lost in the early morning sky until February. Saturn is an early riser this month; the time lord awakens the dawn sky rising around 03:00 AEDT, and finally the Earth is at Solstice on the 21st when here in the south the days are at their longest with the Sun at its most southern declination -23.5 degrees.

SATURN – YOUR PERSONAL HEROIC JOURNEY

Chart Analysis in Modern Medical Astrology



Kira totally captivated us all with her uncomplicated manner that showed her depth of knowledge and skill that comes from her combined background of naturopathy and astrology. Firstly, there was an overview of the planets and their roles in health with many interesting comments worth noting. She then moved on to remind us to always check the balance of the elements and modes in a natal chart and also the Cross of Matter in relation to health matters. If there is an imbalance or over abundance then consider ways to encourage the expression of the energy in positive way. Then move on to check the aspects between the planets and the charts angles before moving on the Houses that Kira spoke of as being how you end up with an ailment. Also look at the sign polarity and house polarity in the chart i.e. Aries/Libra 5th/11th Houses for balance.

Kira visited each house providing an oversight of the house, possible health issues that related and examples of how planets in that House may operate for good health or as a challenge. She hit the nail on the head for me stating "those with a strong or well populated 1st House are not good at resting!" Who me?? Kira spoke of transiting Mars or Saturn crossing the Ascendant (physical body) may trigger an illness and paid special attention to the 6th House, the sign on the cusp and the position of the cusp ruler.

Kira suggested that Robert Carl Jansky's book *Astrology, Nutrition and Health* has a simple explanation of how to calculate the Hyleg of a natal chart said to be the 'giver of life' in a chart and the key planet in longevity. There was a final reminder that astrologers are generally not health professionals nor diagnosticians so should not diagnose illness or health issues but having a general awareness is helpful. If something in person's natal chart or coming transits causes you concern for their health you then you may need to gently, so as not to cause unease refer them to a qualified health professional.

Kira teaches at both Nature Care College and the Earth Institute and holds weekend workshops on medical astrology that I, having attended one would highly recommend.

The Rise and Fall of the Market

2008 has been quite a challenging year creating turmoil for many people globally with the plunge of the stock market. Many clients have asked me when I could see a change in the market, so let's explore.

According to the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) website, the year 1790, the year of the Metal Dog, marked "the birth of the US investment markets", however no specific date is provided.

Over the years there has been constant change within the NYSE with ...

- The establishment of an Exchange Board and the adoption of a constitution in 1817, the year of the Fire Ox;
- A new name in 1863, the year of the Water Pig
- Incorporation as "a not-for-profit corporation" in 1971, the year of the Metal Pig
- A new Board of Directors in 1972, a change in the "decision makers", the year of the Water Rat
- Merger in 2006 with "Archipelago Holdings Inc to form the NYSE Group Inc, a for-profit, publicly, year of the Fire Dog
- Owned company", the year of the Fire Dog
- Merger in 2007 with Euronext N.V. in the year of the Fire Pig

What started as a US market has expanded to global proportions, so a vast range of influences, are now brought to bear upon its activity. In the Chinese astrological system of the 4 Pillars of Destiny, one of the 5 elements-water, wood, fire, earth or metal, is associated with an individual or entity, an industry or market. The 5 elements can then be further characterized by whether they are a Yin element or a Yang element.

Each day, month and year are associated with one or two dominant elements in the "stem" and the "branch", and up to three different "hidden" elements in each of the branches eg. 2008, the year of the Earth Rat is Yang, the Earth is the stem and the Rat is the branch. The Rat is water containing a further "hidden" element of water.

The idea is to have a balance or harmony of elements to provide a smooth flow of energy. If an element is too weak or too strong or if the elements are too yang or too yin, then an imbalance is formed. Most people/charts have an imbalance of energies to some degree, some more than others. As with Western Astrology the time and day of "creation" provides a chart from which information can be extracted to determine the potential trends. If only one piece of information is provided then it is more difficult to extract pertinent information. In the case of the NYSE, we do not have a specific date for commencement, so we would traditionally select an element that characterized the market.

This is where the difficulty starts. Gold or money was once the method of exchange, which could easily be linked to the element of metal; this has changed over the course of history to stocks, bonds and even "futures" in all sorts of industries and markets. So it is not a clear-cut procedure to determine a specific element to the NYSE as it stands (or falls) today.

According to a Feng Shui Master in Hong Kong, the stock market is related to the element of fire. This would correspond with the "volatility" of the market and the expansionist nature of fire, which is to spread or radiate in all directions, the emotionally driven content of the market, but also its vulnerability when it "runs out of fuel".

Whilst researching for this article I did discover a trend, which is related to the element of yin fire. Yin fire in the stem is an extremely vulnerable, temperamental energy, which is associated with illusion-the illusion of profitability, fast gains and as a result, over-confidence. The Yin fire occurs in the stem of a year every 10 years however it does not link up with the same branch for a period of 60 years. Yin fire in the branch of a year occurs every 12 years and this energy is associated with secrecy, hidden knowledge and withheld information.

Let's look at some dates of financial crisis or meltdown according to the NYSE website and look at the elements ...

- 1837 a year of Yin fire-stem
- 1857 a year of Yin fire-stem
- 1869 a year of Yin fire in the branch
- 1873 a year of the Water Rooster-very strong water
- 1907 a year of Yin fire-stem
- 1914-WWI
- 1929 a year of Yin fire in the branch
- 1932 year of the Water Monkey-very strong water
- 1987 a year of Yin fire-stem
- 1988 a year of Yin fire-stem
- 2001 a year of Yin fire in the branch
- 2007 a year of yin fire-stem
- 2008 water strong with unstable earth-earth is associated with property and housing.

Certainly every 10th year of the Yin fire in the stem or every 12th year with Yin Fire in the branch is not shown as a year of crisis, but war and other events also impact on the market, modifying the confidence levels of investors. WWI was fought "hands on" with a large contingent of personnel. Since then the deployment of personnel has decreased and war is waged with huge destruction wrought at the flip of a trigger or by pressing a button. So whereas in WWI everyone throughout the world became directly involved to varying degrees, nowadays war can be waged without impacting directly on the lives of millions of people.

Another intriguing factor is that the market commonly falls in the month of October. In the five-element theory, the Dog, which relates to specific years, but also to the month of October, is called the graveyard of the element of Fire. It is also worth noting that if we take 1790 as the birth of the NYSE, this was the year of the Dog also. Is there an inherent penalty? In this system of astrology, when we have 2 Dogs together it indicates retreat and withdrawal.

So let's look at recent events...

In the year 2007, the year of the Fire Pig, the elements of fire and water dominated, with "hidden" elements of water and wood. The fire element generally is one of optimism; however the Yin quality of the fire in this year is unstable, tending towards illusion, which can lead to over-confidence and rash judgements being made. From the above list of dates, one would expect a crisis in this year. Perhaps the merger in 2007 with Euronext N.V. prolonged the inevitable.

In the year 2008, the Earth Rat, earth and water were the dominant elements with water as the "hidden" element. The earth and water in this year have a Yang quality, which is stronger, more active and forceful than the Yin energy of 2007.

So whilst the element of fire was represented in 2007, it was lacking in 2008. Water controls or when strong as in a Yang year, water destroys the element of fire. The Earth resting on Water tends to destabilize and dampen the property market.

In the early part of 2008 the months of February, May, June and July contained the element of fire, but during the months of August and September, both metal months, (metal supports water) the element of water was strengthened further.

There was some hidden fire in the month of October (the month of the Dog), but it was the more illusory yin fire again, which as previously shown seems to be detrimental rather than supportive and we potentially have the 2 Dogs penalty. During the months of November and December, both water months, the water element is further supported.

January 2009 is an earth month and is still associated with the water element of 2008, as the New Year does not commence until 4 February 2009. (The 4 Pillars system of Chinese astrology is based on the solar year, not the lunar year of other forms of Chinese astrology). The earth will help to control the water, but it is not until February that a glimmer of fire returns in the monthly elements. At this time the energy of the Year of the Earth Ox starts to add weight to the earth element also. March contains some fire, though a little unstable. It is not until the Fire months of May and June arrive that the element of fire appears more strongly. So I would tend to expect that the stock market will not make any major gains much before the middle of 2009.

On a brighter note, the year 2009, the Year of the Earth Ox is earth upon earth so it will tend to be a more harmonious year.
