The Twice Born or The Living Dead? Pluto in the Birthchart

Speaker's Report

Sherrynne Dalby - The Child Within

Our speaker for August was Sherrynne Dalby who is a past president of the AANSW, examiner for the FAA and current author of "Star Parenting"- "What astrology reveals about your child's personality". Sherrynne is mother to seven (yes 7!) children and has been Mother of the Year, twice!

Sherrynne's presentation was based on the content of her latest book and was certainly a hit with the audience. Sherrynne went on to explain how her book looks at the horoscope of the child "evolving" rather than just the "snap-shot" at birth. In particular, Sherrynne focuses on the Sun- the child's "will"; the Moon – the child's "emotions"; and the ascendant- as "first impressions". The Midheaven, and the connection between planets is no less important, particularly as the chart progresses.

Sherrynne presented a chart for the planets and the time it takes each planet to reach the first square, the first opposition, the second square and the first conjunction, to their respective natal position and how this is evident in the child's behaviour. For example, a Mars return is referred to as the "terrible twos", and Saturn's first square (6yr 5mths to eight years), opposition (14 to 16 yrs), second square (20yrs 11mths to 22yrs 9mths), and return (28yrs 5mths to 30yrs) all reflective of important stages in a child's development and personality (approx.7), possible rebelliousness (14-16), responsibility (approx.21) and ultimate maturity(28-30).

In particular, Sherrynne pointed out that the Moon is most important in the child's chart as it shows the emotional state, the child's instincts and how we respond through our emotions, and more obviously the mother and our first experience of love. It also represents our inner self and our memory (aspected through emotion). Hard aspects to the Moon may show how the child views the relationship between parents (Sun), or with relating altogether (Mercury), or a tendency to go over the top emotionally (Jupiter).

Other interesting aspects of Sherrynne's talk include the possibility that Mercury in a fire sign (of a child's chart) may result in the child being a stutterer, whereas Mercury in an earth sign may result in the later development of speech (to get it right). Interestingly, some children born with Mercury retrograde showed signs of genius ie. Gina Davis and Steve Martin who have Mercury Retrograde are both members of Mensa.

I am sure the presentation was an "eye-opener" for any parent with troublesome children and I am sure members and their respective guests will be further enlightened if they wish to purchase Sherrynne's book!

Auxiliary Angles – Not Just Helpers in the Horoscope

Ask astrologers about the angles of the horoscope and the standard answer would be the Ascendant and the Midheaven. Everyone know about the Ascendant and the Midheaven. Some astrologers have some understanding of the Equatorial Ascendant and the Vertex, too. Hardly anyone knows about or uses two other vital angles: the Polar Ascendant and the Co-Ascendant.

So this talk is a small step in addressing this situation. We won't spend much time on the Ascendant and the Midheaven. But we will ponder what it means to enter into links with the Equatorial Ascendant, in the land where shadows lie, and where balance can be lost or won. We will look upon the fateful vortex that ripples and eddies around the Vertex, and maybe dare to enter it, and discover we can come out of it again. We will think about what it means to deal with the energies of the Co-Ascendant, which is either the gift that keeps on giving, or the grit that never stops annoying (and sometimes both at once). And last but not least – maybe most of all – we shall honour the Polar Ascendant, the axis of vast power that shows – just maybe the mightiest of all energy exchanges any being has with the world, and which can colour the individual horoscope more vividly and strongly than any other angle anywhere, and sometimes more than all the rest put together.

We shall look at the angles of the charts of the rich and famous, and a few infamous folk as well. There's an old rock song that tells us the power is in the passion. For astrologers the power is in many places, but there are no other places quite like the angles of the horoscope for serious power junkies. If you want to get with the power, then get with the program and come along.



Roderick Kidston began learning astrology in 1974 at the age of thirteen from his self-taught mother. An early fan of adding asteroids to the astrologer's repertoire, he now considers it difficult to read a horoscope without the 'minor planets'. The study of harmonics has also been a passion, and for the last decade he has investigated how harmonics may explain both material evolutionary potential and the inner drives of mind and soul. Roderick is interested in more 'integral' approach to astrology that links with developments in depth psychology and metaphysics, including the new physics. This includes the new insights offered by the spiral dynamics theory of the evolution of consciousness. He wrote for the Wellspring *.AstroLog* since it was first published (as the *WellBeing Astrology Guide*) in 1997 until it ceased in 2008, and he has been published in the FAA Journal and in two other small journals in Australia. He has taught astrology in Canberra, given talks and workshops in several cities and he has been a speaker at the Marriage of Minds conference in 2003, and at the 2006 and 2008 FAA Conferences in Melbourne and Sydney. He gave an informal presentation on the asteroid Iris at the NCGR Conference in Baltimore in 2007, and was most recently a speaker at the FAA Conference in Brisbane in January 2010

GODDESS OF THE DEEP REVISITED

'Unfathomable' - A Sedna Story

Some astrologers may, like myself, have been aware that around the time of and ever since the discovery of the dwarf planet, initially dubbed '2003 VB12', in the outer reaches of our solar system and later officially christened Sedna, there appears to have been increased emphasis on events which echo some of the themes associated to the various myths of this Inuit goddess of the ocean, its borders and its creatures.

For those unfamiliar and to refresh the memory of those who may have forgotten some to the details of the mythology surrounding Sedna, it would perhaps be helpful to re-cap the main ideas. Sedna is believed to be the Inuit creation goddess having jurisdiction over life and death. One of the main versions of the story is that she was a beautiful young girl whose father, to lighten the load in the boat in which they were both travelling, which was threatening to sink them both, pushed his daughter over the side into the water, whereupon she clung to the side of the boat to prevent herself drowning. Her father, to save his own skin, cut off all her fingers and she sank to the bottom of the ocean. Some versions of the story mention her husband as the culprit. The severed fingers became the whales and the walruses, polar bears, dolphins, and other sea creatures which the Inuit depend on for their survival. They invoke her protection and assistance in their hunting activities.

As suggested above, over the years there have been newsworthy and tragic events having a Sedna theme, such as the death of beautiful young model Caroline Byrne, whose name and that of her boyfriend Gordon Wood were known in almost every Australian household at the time of her death. Caroline's body was found at the foot of the notorious suicide spot, The Gap, near Sydney's South Head on 8.6.95, the day after she was last seen alive. The media attention and legal proceedings lasted years, finally resulted in Gordon Wood being found guilty of her murder.

Shortly after sunset on 24.3.2005 Janet Campbell tragically fell over 50 metres to her death at the Royal National Park onto rocks near the Figure of Eight Pool, at the ocean's edge. Des Campbell, her husband of 6 weeks, a former policeman and paramedic, was found guilty of pushing Janet to her death in a 3 week, May 2010 trial. The jury believed that greed for her money was the motivation behind the crime.

The entire nation was shocked by the death of Darcey, a small 4 year old girl, thrown over the edge of the West Gate Bridge into the water by her father in Melbourne at around 9 a.m. on 29.1.09.

The two part "Australian Story - Unfathomable" documentary screened on ABCTV on the 2nd and 9th of August 2010 brought to mind another such example. 'Unfathomable' is the story of the yet unsolved mystery of the death of a 26 year old American woman off the Queensland coast just south east of Townsville on the morning of 22.10.03, just 11 days after her wedding. Astrologers will no doubt recall that it was just 23 days later, on 14.11.03, that the first computerised photographs were taken of '2003 VB12', Sedna. When these photographs were examined on the 17.11.03, it was observed that the body had moved positions in relation to background stars. The announcement of this discovery was delayed until 15.03.04.

The Swiss Ephemeris for Sedna, available online, gives the position of the at the time extremely slow-moving station retrograde body at 18°12' Taurus at the young woman's death on 22.10.03 and at 17°57' Taurus at the discovery of the astronomical body. At the time of the announcement of the discovery on 15.3.04 it was at 17°41' Taurus, having turned direct around 1.2.04 at 17°29' Taurus. At the showing of Part 1 of the TV program over seven years later, it had moved forward from its discovery position by only 4°33' to 22°30' Taurus. The orbit of Sedna is believed to be an incredible 10,500 years!

The story "Unfathomable", tells of the young couple from the southern U.S. state of Alabama who came to Queensland on their honeymoon for a diving holiday in October, 2003. At approx. 10:30

AM AEST on 22.10.03, over the wreck of the S.S. Yongala, south east of Townsville, the beautiful young bride, Tina Watson (nee Thomas, b. 13.2.77, Landstuhl, Germany), was last seen by some of the other 43 divers in the group, in an underwater bear hug with her husband, Gabe. A short time later Gabe broke the surface shouting to other divers that his wife had sunk to the bottom despite his efforts to rescue her.

The incident was somewhat of a mystery to everybody, especially as Gabe had a certificate in dive rescue. One experienced diver interviewed stated '*none of this story made sense to an experienced diver*'. Gabe was later charged by Queensland police with murder but instead pleaded guilty to the lesser charge of manslaughter and was duly convicted of the latter in a Townsville Court, receiving a 12 month gaol sentence. An appeal by the prosecution saw this extended to 18 months, which he is currently still serving in Brisbane

The program aimed to present new evidence proving Gabe's guilt of the murder of his wife. The theory put forward, that he turned off Tina's oxygen supply and held her firmly in a bear hug until she had expired, whereupon her body then sank to the bottom, but not before he had turned her oxygen tank back on to avoid suspicion. One wonders if the course he took and certificate gained in dive rescue operations might have been to ascertain the exact workings of the necessary oxygen equipment, how to turn it off, how long it would take to die, the effects of pressure at various depths, etc.

Although the motive for murder does not appear to be clear at this stage and money seems to have been only a minor consideration, there is evidence to suggest that perhaps Gabe is of unsound mind. One person from the U.S. interviewed said they felt that he had killed his wife so that 'nobody else could have her'.

When her body was flown home to Alabama, she was buried in a local cemetery, but later Gabe had her coffin exhumed and relocated to a plot he had purchased for the purpose. It was then discovered that any flowers that her family placed on the grave were mysteriously disappearing. Local police investigators then set up surveillance equipment and discovered that it was indeed Gabe who was collecting the flowers and throwing them into the nearest garbage bin. Surely odd behaviour at best.

As far as any astrological connection between the time of showing of the two TV episodes and the timing of the original events, one thing that does seem obvious is that the New Moon of Tuesday, 10.8.10, at 1:09 PM AEST, just 17 hours after the showing of the second and final part of the series, fell at 17°25' Leo, which is closely square to Sedna's earlier position at key times, and in fact only 4' from an exact square to its position at 17°29' Taurus when it went Direct on 1.2.04. The chart for this New Moon in relation to the chart for the announcement on 15.3.04 displays a powerful Grand Cross in early Cardinal signs, always an important part of the zodiac, and involving no less than 8 planets (6 transiting and 2 natal) - namely T. Uranus (0°07' Aries), T. Saturn (1°45' Libra), T. Jupiter (2°54' Libra), T. Venus (3°03' Libra), T. Pluto (3°06' Capricorn), N. Saturn (6°21' Cancer), N. Mercury (6°31' Libra), and T. Mars (6°52' Libra). No doubt of significance is the fact that T. Uranus is currently located at the Aries Point, possibly the most important degree of the zodiac.

Perhaps out of all this it may be appropriate to extract one dynamic in particular as being of paramount importance - and in this writer's opinion it would be that of Transiting Saturn Square Natal Saturn, always an important life or situation changing transit. Saturn either squares or opposes itself every seven years and it is now almost seven years since the original events. The aspect first came into orb around December, 2009 (N. Saturn at 6°21' Cancer in the discovery announcement chart of 15.3.04 - however at a later degree in the earlier charts because retrograde, T. Saturn Station Retrograde at 4°39' Libra on 13.1.10, which after its retrograde period is again coming back into range of exactitude [due 19.9.10]). Perhaps we shall see some new developments or even resolution around this time, and perhaps ongoing as T. Saturn squares its retrograde natal position in the earlier charts.

Saturn, variously known as the Lord of Karma, The Taskmaster, The Grim Reaper, The Teacher, or The Judge, has a fondness for exacting his dues and likes to settle old scores and mete out punishment where it is deserved. To quote Robert Hand on this transit, "*This is a time of testing*".

Just for the record, yet another story with a Sedna theme surfaced during the week between the showing of the two part series when news reports announced that on Friday, 6.8.10 a coronial enquiry into the mysterious death of Katrina Ploy back in December, 2006 (she was last seen alive on 17.12.06) concluded that her death was still a mystery. A car and clothes belonging to the beautiful 25 year old were found adjacent to The Gap, referred to earlier, the day after her disappearance, a week later her body was discovered floating off Lady Bay Beach just inside the Harbour. The body showed no signs of the injuries usually associated with a fall onto rocks from such a great height and prevailing winds and currents at the time did not appear to have been responsible for the location of the body's discovery.

In addition, a slightly different scenario occurred the same week, but one which could also be said to have a connection to Sedna themes, and that was that on Sunday morning, 1.8.10, the day before the ABCTV program first went to air, a little 6 year old girl named Kiesha Abrahams was reported by her mother missing from her bed that morning, having not been seen since the previous evening, and has not been seen since. In fact, things are even more mysterious because friends and acquaintances say they have not seen her since 7th July, nor has she attended school in that time. Her mother gave birth to a new baby about a month ago. Each member of her family, including her natural father and her mother's present partner have been interviewed, and the latter two still remain under suspicion. Police are searching local dams and one could easily make the assumption that her body will eventually be found in one of them.

The foregoing tragic events aside, which would appear to imply the persecution of the Feminine by the negative Masculine, my feeling as always is that the highest expression of the energies associated with Sedna is the healing in the coming Age of the wounded Feminine and the latter's return to fully empowered expression. However, these incidents, although thankfully occurring only rarely, when they do so, perhaps serve to awaken our awareness, reminding us of the status quo in certain instances, and galvanising us, albeit in a symbolic way, into action to assist and empower that reality.
