Auxiliary Angles – Not Just Helpers in the Horoscope

Ask astrologers about the angles of the horoscope and the standard answer would be the Ascendant and the Midheaven. Everyone know about the Ascendant and the Midheaven. Some astrologers have some understanding of the Equatorial Ascendant and the Vertex, too. Hardly anyone knows about or uses two other vital angles: the Polar Ascendant and the Co-Ascendant.

So this talk is a small step in addressing this situation. We won't spend much time on the Ascendant and the Midheaven. But we will ponder what it means to enter into links with the Equatorial Ascendant, in the land where shadows lie, and where balance can be lost or won. We will look upon the fateful vortex that ripples and eddies around the Vertex, and maybe dare to enter it, and discover we can come out of it again. We will think about what it means to deal with the energies of the Co-Ascendant, which is either the gift that keeps on giving, of the grit that never stops annoying (and sometimes both at once). And last but not least – maybe most of all – we shall honour the Polar Ascendant, the axis of vast power that shows – just maybe the mightiest of all energy exchanges any being has with the world, and which can colour the individual horoscope more vividly and strongly than any other angle anywhere, and sometimes more than all the rest put together.

We shall look at the angles of the charts of the rich and famous, and a few infamous folk as well. There's an old rock song that tells us the power is in the passion. For astrologers the power is in many places, but there are no other places quite like the angles of the horoscope for serious power junkies. If you want to get with the power, then get with the program and come along.

Zane has been involved with astrology since 1969, and what he loves most is astrological research. In November 1977, Zane read a story in the New York Times telling of the discovery of a "Tenth Planet", and he was very excited. Immediately he wrote to Dr. Brian Marsden at the Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory, who was kind enough to send Zane an ephemeris for the new body covering several months. Zane then contacted Al H. Morrison, who had an associate of his translate the positions into zodiacal ones. Zane began to study Chiron's transits. Dr. Marsden sent more complete ephemerides shortly, and they published these as soon as they could. In 1978, Zane organized the Association for Studying Chiron (ASC) which began collecting data and information about Chiron research from astrologers the world over.

Very early, Chiron proved itself to be a major astrological influence. This information was then printed in a newsletter, *The Key* (first issue March 31, 1979.) The ASC continued in its purpose until 1986, and during its existence a great wealth of information on Chiron was collected. (Plans are in the works to reprint 'The Key')

Zane wrote the first booklet on Chiron, "Interpreting Chiron", as well as one of the most heavily referenced books on the subject, "Essence and Application: A View From Chiron." Zane has also been heavily involved in researching other Centaurean bodies like Pholus and Nessus, as well as the new bodies out past Pluto such as Eris. (The Mountain Astrologer carried Zane's piece on Eris as their cover story in their April/May 2007 issue.)

In order to share Zane's love of Chiron and other new astrological tools, he has lectured throughout the United States, as well as in Toronto, and in 1985 lectured in Ireland, Scotland, and all over England, including speaking at the AA Conference in Loughborough.

Zane currently resides in Atlanta, Georgia, where he is working on a new Chiron book for the 21st Century. Zane maintains a website with information on Chiron, and many other bodies. For more information visit: zanestein.com/chiron.htm (very impressive – note from Chris Turner)

Speakers' Report

Kira Sutherland - Elective Lunar Surgery

Kira presented an excellent lecture at the September meeting. Electing a date for surgery (as with anything else) in Kira's own words is challenging – even if you do select a very good date it is difficult to be able to have the perfect time fitting in with medical specialists.

Kira opened with a quote from Plato in The republic 382BC, "The cure of the part should not be attempted without treatment of the whole", further it suggested that the error of treatment is separating the body from the soul.

For Elective Lunar Surgery there is no perfect date – but there are days that are definitely better than others, it is an aid to make the surgical experience as smooth as possible.

Kira outlined basic rules to follow, involving the patient's chart, transits, retrogradations, aspects, astrological signs and their associated body part and importantly lunar phases. Kira explained her colour technique, using four colours – one for the worst days, one for the bad days, one of okay days and the last for the best days. In Kira's words "It is about finding the days that will possible work and eliminating the very bad days"

After Kira went through the basic rules it become increasing obvious that finding a day is challenging, in the example that Kira provided after the very bad days were eliminated, within a calendar month there was 2 good days, 3 okay days and 2 at a stretch days. We commenced by following the rules to eliminate the worst days:

- Best to operate with in 5 days either side of the New Moon = less swelling or bleeding
- Do Not operate with in 5 days of the full moon
- Never operate when the Moon is in the same signs as the patients natal Moon or Sun
- Avoid surgery which the moon is in the sign ruling the body part to be worked on
- Do not operate when the Moon is in the sign of the natal Ascendant for this will lower vitality
- Avoid operating when the Sun is in the sign ruling the relevant body part
- Let the Moon be in a fixed sign when possible (Taurus, Leo, Scorpio and Aquarius)
- Avoid the Moon in mutable sign when possible (Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius and Pisces)
- Avoid surgery when the Moon is void of course – preferable the Moon should be swift in its daily motion.

As you can see if you add weekends, doctor's working days and holidays, the list of good days for the procedure narrows. It is suggested as it is elective surgery that the client give you a period of several months to work with. Mercury and Mars should not be retrograde, nor should the planet representing the condition be retrograde or exactly square the Lunar Nodes.

The 12th house should be free of any negative or afflicting conditions as this our rules hospitals and ones recovery while in hospital. The Moon should not have hard aspects to the natal malefic and the Sun, it is of benefit is the there is a trine or sextile to Jupiter and Venus.

It is important to make sure all the data you have is correct – particularly the type of operation, as it is often plastic surgery get specifics – the rulership of the operation will be effected if you are not given the correct information. Waning moons reduce swelling and recurring growth, if the surgery requires growth of tissue a waxing moon is better. Avoid surgery two weeks before and two weeks after any eclipse and the period in between the eclipses.

If you are able to get your surgeon's birth details synastry rules apply.

Most importantly – follow up with your client the results of the surgery – there is nothing better to learn from than experience.
